1. Active School Flag (ASF): Review and Planning Coaching Feedback

- Initially, some sessions were a bit crazy

2. Social Media Strategy

Ideas

- The school's social media 'presence' could be better:
 - There's an opportunity for the Student Council to lead the BCNS Social Media Strategy.
 - We'll begin with Twitter learning what it is and how to make better use of it for the purpose of sharing our learning from BCNS.
 - We'll begin with a mini-lesson with all Senior Room children (Friday, 11/02/22) and we'll go from there.
 - This experience will be valuable for all in sixth class, i.e., to be able to say, 'I was a member of the team that led the school's Social Media Strategy!'
 - Our aim, at first, is to post more frequently than once a week/ month. We'll aim to post 3-5 times per week.
